Welcome Mrs. Darling!



Striving for a Safe School- Procedure Changes

Lucas Elementary School strives to be a safe and secure place for our children. While we are a community banded in traditions, we are also a growing community with new faces and families. While growth is great, it also can bring faces to the schools that are not familiar. As we have a change over in staff throughout the elementary, as well as some wonderful new families, we want to continue to be safe and secure. Please keep in mind there will be some changes in basic procedures related to entering the building, signing students out, and dismissal.

- Entering the Building- Don't be surprised as you seek entry to the building, to be asked your name and purpose for entry to the building. You may even be asked for an I.D.
- **Signing out students** Be prepared to show I.D. if you come into the building to sign out a student. It is hard op instantly know the face of every parent, grandparent, aunt or uncle who comes into the building. If someone other than the direct guardian is picking up a child, a note is to be sent in, by the guardian, at the start of the day. Any day a student is leaving school early, a note should be sent in at the start of the day.
- **Dismissal** Car Pick-Up- Parents picking up students in the vehicle line at the end of the school day are to register for a vehicle pass. This pass will have the family's last name printed on it. Keep it in your car and show it on the dash upon pick-up. Multiple passes can be requested. Registration can be done in the office during the week of August 10-14 and passes can be picked up in the resource fair during open house. Additional passes can be requested after school starts.
- **Dismissal** Cafeteria Pick-Up- Many districts are doing away with parents coming into the building for pick-up at dismissal. Lucas Elementary is not quite ready to take this leap; therefore students can still be picked up in the cafeteria after the 3:15 bell. Parents coming to the building for pick-up are asked not to arrive before 3:05 and to come through the main entrance and leave through the side entrance of the cafeteria. All parents will be expected to sign into the building at the front door and again sign out their child(ren) before leaving the building.
