

Spring State Testing

Information for Students and Families

As identified through Ohio State Law, Lucas Local School district's students will participate in the state testing in mathematics, English language arts, science and social studies. These tests help measure student progress toward Ohio's Learning Standards. The state test results provide one measurement of student learning. The results they show help identify the knowledge and skills students have as they move on in education.

The Ohio Department of Education works with the American Institutes for Research (AIR), one of the country's largest student assessment providers. Each test has two parts. Lucas Schools have chosen for students to take part 1 on one day and part 2 on another day, providing shorter sitting times. All students will take state tests online.
